

Rowley Public Library Behavior Policy

We expect that all behavior be in line with proper use of a Library and respectful of staff and all patrons.

- Use only respectful language and tone of voice.
- Apparel or clothing should be appropriate for all ages and respectful of all patrons and staff.
- The parking area, drive, and walkways must be safe and unobstructed for both pedestrians and drivers.
- Library computers may be used only for accessing non-offensive content.

Anyone violating the Library's Behavior Policy may be asked to leave immediately and may not be allowed to return for an extended period of time. We expect that all patron behavior will ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all. The following is an example, but not an exclusive, list of behavior that is not allowed:

Smoking, vaping, alcohol, intoxication, recreational drugs (legal or illegal), candy & gum, animals that are not service animals or part of a library program, weapons.
